The ASME DRIVEN 2026 Technical Poster Session coincides with the **Welcome Reception on Monday, September 14 between 5:30 – 7:00 PM** and will take place in **the Windover Room on the 1st floor of [The Westin Southfield Detroit](#)**.

Each presenter is responsible for **printing and bringing a physical poster** to the conference. Posters must not exceed the dimensions of **45" H x 36" W**. Poster boards and thumbtacks will be available onsite. **Kindly arrive at 4:30 PM on Monday, September 14th to mount and display your poster.**

To recognize outstanding contributions, the TSD Executive Committee will present four awards:

- **Best Overall Poster Award**
- **Best Student Poster Award**
- **Most Innovative Concept Award**
- **Largest Real-World Impact Award**

Posters will be evaluated by a panel of judges that includes representatives from both academia and industry to ensure a balanced and insightful review. Each poster will be independently reviewed by multiple judges using a **5-point Likert scale** (5 = EXCELLENT, 1 = POOR), based on the following criteria:

- **T. Technical Quality** – Depth, rigor, novelty, and appropriate citation of technical content
- **V. Visual Clarity** – Organization, readability, quality of figures/graphics
- **O. Oral Presentation** – Clarity, confidence, delivery of poster explanation
- **D. Discussion & Q&A** – Ability to handle questions and engage in meaningful discussion

Final award decisions will be based on the compiled scores. Winners will be announced at the **Awards Banquet on Wednesday, September 16, between 5:30 – 7:00 PM**.

2. Provide the **full name of the presenter**, and indicate whether **the presenter is a student or non-student**
