



## Student Travel Award

The **2020 ASME-CIE Hackathon** will offer travel stipends (the amount is to be confirmed; tentatively \$500) to support both undergraduate and graduate students attending the Hackathon.

Please note that there are only a **limited number of travel awards available** this year. Please self-evaluate and/or check with your advisor to determine if you should apply for a travel award or not. If so, please apply as soon as you can.

### Eligibility:

ASME-CIE Hackathon Travel Award Applicants:

- 1) The student must be attending a university or college as a graduate or undergraduate student in 2020.
- 2) Applicants need to be a student member of ASME.
- 3) Awardees are required to register and attend the entire Hackathon event.

### What to Submit:

The application should include:

- 1) A one-page personal statement. Please explain how attending to the ASME-CIE Hackathon will support your study, research and/or career development.
- 2) A one-page travel plan for attending the Hackathon. Please also indicate your travel budget and whether you have any additional sources of financial support.
- 3) A one-page resume. Please also include your ASME student membership information.
- 4) A support letter from your advisor is strongly recommended.
